The History Museum of Mobile's Learning Lunch Program on August 9th at 12pm will feature Dr. Kari Frederickson of the University of Alabama:

Deep South Dynasty: The Bankheads of Alabama

Kari Frederickson is Professor of History at the University of Alabama. She writes extensively on the political, social, and cultural history of the American South. She is the author of three award-winning books, including *The Dixiecrat Revolt and the End of the Solid South* (2001) which won the Harry S Truman book award in 2002; and *Cold War Dixie: Militarization and Modernization in the American South* (2013) which was awarded the Bennett H. Wall Award for the Best Book in in Economic History from the Southern Historical Association.

She will speak on the topic of her most recent book, *Deep South Dynasty: The Bankheads of Alabama*, which examines three generations of this once powerful but now largely forgotten family who were the chief architects of the New South.
